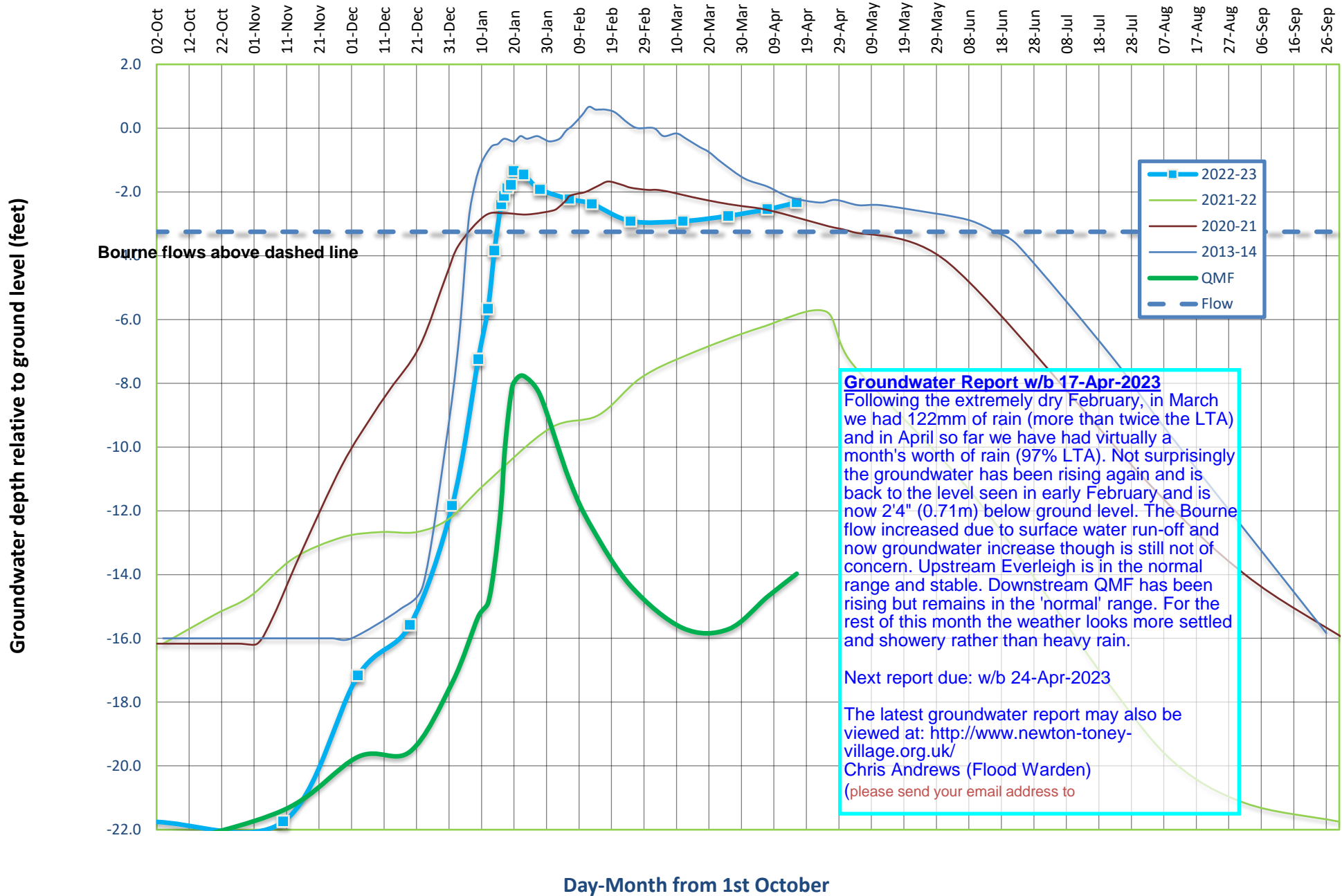


Newton Toney Groundwater Level 2022-23



Groundwater Report w/b 17-Apr-2023
 Following the extremely dry February, in March we had 122mm of rain (more than twice the LTA) and in April so far we have had virtually a month's worth of rain (97% LTA). Not surprisingly the groundwater has been rising again and is back to the level seen in early February and is now 2'4" (0.71m) below ground level. The Bourne flow increased due to surface water run-off and now groundwater increase though is still not of concern. Upstream Everleigh is in the normal range and stable. Downstream QMF has been rising but remains in the 'normal' range. For the rest of this month the weather looks more settled and showery rather than heavy rain.
