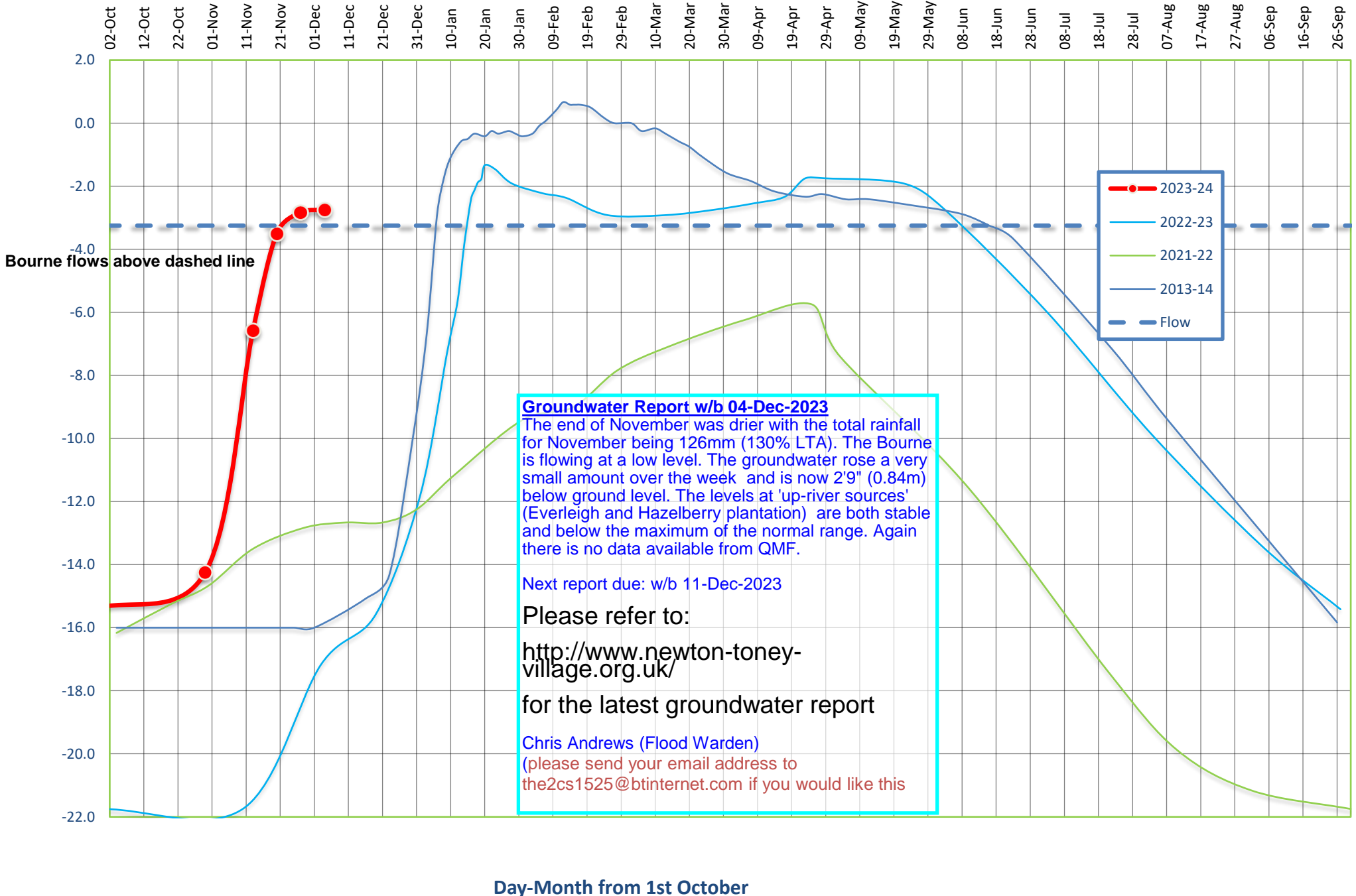


# Newton Toney Groundwater Level 2023-24

**Groundwater Report w/b 04-Dec-2023**  
 The end of November was drier with the total rainfall for November being 126mm (130% LTA). The Bourne is flowing at a low level. The groundwater rose a very small amount over the week and is now 2'9" (0.84m) below ground level. The levels at 'up-river sources' (Everleigh and Hazelberry plantation) are both stable and below the maximum of the normal range. Again there is no data available from QMF.
