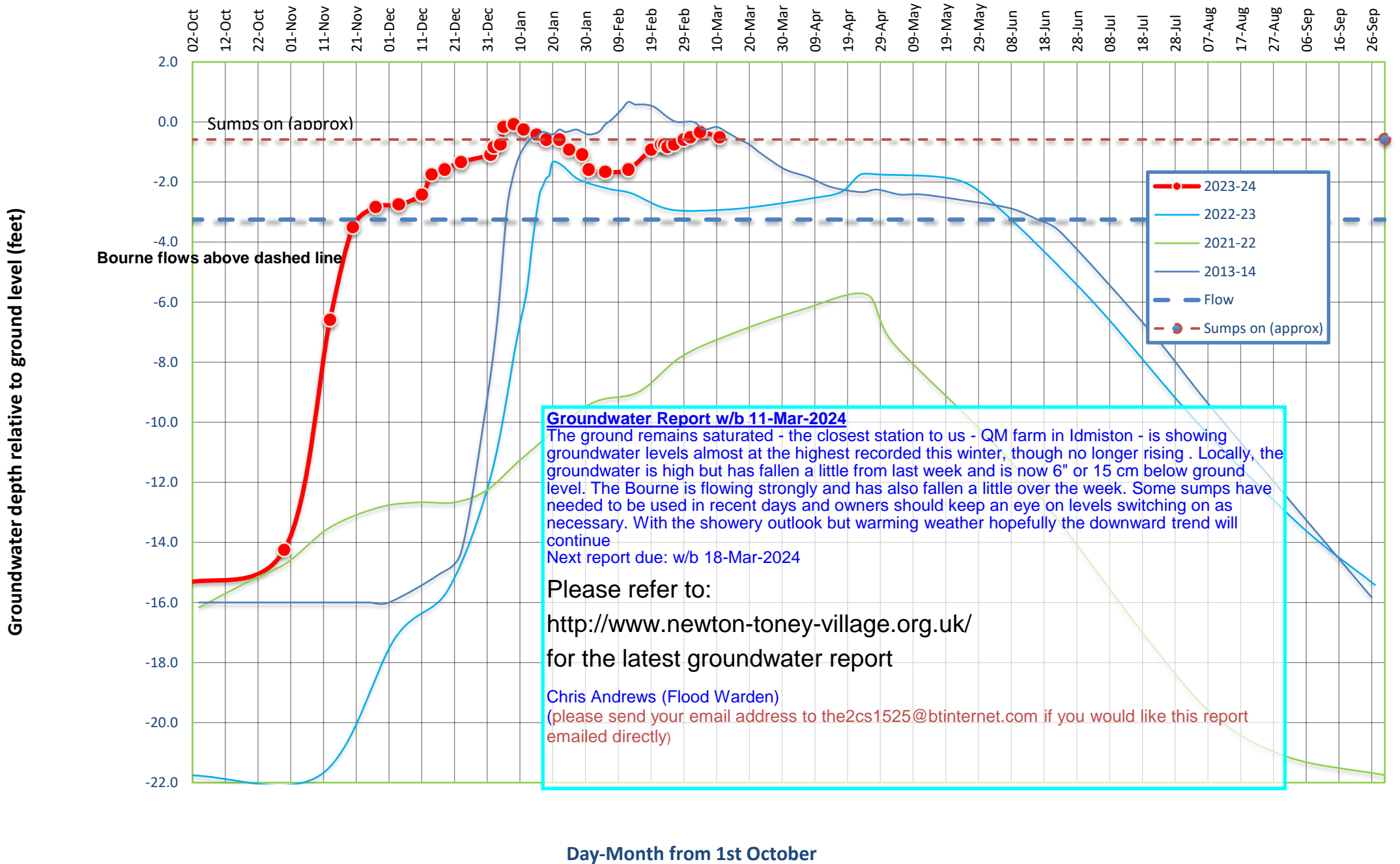


Newton Toney Groundwater Level 2023-24



Groundwater Report w/b 11-Mar-2024

The ground remains saturated - the closest station to us - QM farm in Idmiston - is showing groundwater levels almost at the highest recorded this winter, though no longer rising. Locally, the groundwater is high but has fallen a little from last week and is now 6" or 15 cm below ground level. The Bourne is flowing strongly and has also fallen a little over the week. Some sumps have needed to be used in recent days and owners should keep an eye on levels switching on as necessary. With the showery outlook but warming weather hopefully the downward trend will continue
